Approximate Duration: 7 hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

On your tour into KSC, you'll see Space Shuttle Launch Pads from the four-story Observation Gantry. Next, the Apollo/Saturn V Center offers an inspirational and exhilarating look into mankind's quest for the moon. You'll relive the historic launch of Apollo 8 at the Firing Room Theater, marvel at a monstrous 363-foot Saturn V moon rocket and witness the harrowing final moments before man landed on the moon. You can float effortlessly along with astronauts in the International Space Station during the heart-pounding 3-D Space Station: IMAX® movie, shown on a 5 1/2-story screen. NASA Up Close

Approximate Duration: 7 hours

Level 1

Want to get an even closer look at the world's busiest space launch facility? The NASA Up Close tour, led by a trained space expert, will take you on a two-hour narrated journey through the Space Shuttle program, from launch preparation to lift-off. Included are extremely close stops by Space Shuttle Launch Pads A and B and the huge Vehicle Assembly Building (VAB), which houses the Space Shuttle prior to its roll-out to the launch pads. The tour also takes you through the industrial area of Kennedy Space Center, home of both the International Space Station Processing Facility and the Operations and Checkout (O&C) building, where Astronauts prepare for their flights. The Shuttle Landing Facility and the massive, six-million-pound Crawler-Transporter, which transports the Shuttle from the VAB to its launch pad are also featured. The NASA Up Close tour includes all this plus a KSC souvenir booklet, a collectable lapel pin and everything in the 'Kennedy Space Center' tour.

Airboat Adventure

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 1

Imagine seeing the world in a whole new light. This educational excursion takes you into the seldom-visited heart of natural Florida. Experience beautiful protected wetland hammocks within the heart of the Central Florida Everglades. Your journey starts with your guide's narrative en route to Lone Cabbage, a 100-year-old outpost and turn-of-the-century fish camp located in the middle of the back country. At the camp you'll see a live wildlife presentation and some participants will even get to hold a live alligator. Then, board your 15-passenger airboat for a guided adventure into the Central Florida Everglades traveling at speeds of almost 40 mph. Travel by airboat into pristine sections of fresh water marshes and up river, into the Bald-Cypress Swamp, home of the Florida alligator, American bald eagle and a huge assortment of wildlife. Certified eco-guides will ensure that you come away with a new and profound understanding of Florida's vastly different land and plant communities and the importance of their interrelationship and preservation. You'll see alligators, birds, reptiles and learn of the unique swamp life up-close, as your expedition explores an area of the Central Florida Everglades. Afterwards, you may sample alligator tail and enjoy a soft drink.

Kayak on the Indian River Lagoon

Approximate Duration: 3 ½ hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

Your tour begins en route to the kayak launch site, as a certified eco-guide narrates the significance of this endangered backwater estuary, a sanctuary for the endangered West Indian manatees, bottlenose dolphins, Florida alligators, hundreds of birds, many species of animals, and 1,000 species of plants. Navigate down this inland, protected back-water estuary on your two-person kayak. Halfway through your tour, stop to rest and explore the desolate island. Then, take an easy nature walk through the off-shore barrier island to observe the diverse eco-system hammock and learn of its significance and inter relationship with the estuary. This is a slow, peaceful exploration through nature. It's safe and easy for the first-time kayaker or the experienced explorer alike.

Note: Participants must be at least 6 years of age. Sunscreen and a hat are recommended. A bottle of water will be given to guests.

Wildlife Encounter – A Pontoon Boat Cruise

On this fascinating educational adventure led by a certified eco-guide, you'll experience the unique wildlife of the Banana River, America's largest estuary. The Banana River, part of the Indian River Lagoon system, contains over 5,000 species of plants and animals. You'll learn of its significance as you cruise the smooth, inland waters around Cocoa Beach's Thousand Islands aboard the shallow-draft, 55-passenger pontoon boat in safety and comfort. You may observe bottlenose dolphins as they feed and swim around the boat. Keep your eyes open for the endangered manatees, as more of these unique marine mammals live in these waters than any other area in Florida. Water wildlife abounds. This is an easy guided and narrated tour that requires no walking. The pontoon boat has a surround-sound and speaker system. You'll be treated to one soft drink during the cruise.

Caravan Safari of Black Point Trail

This is a guided birding and photographic expedition on the third largest refuge in North America. Merritt Island National Wildlife Refuge holds the distinction of having the third most species of birds and wildlife anywhere in the country. Begin with a film orientation at the Visitor's Center, then proceed to the impounded salt marsh's hidden dirt trail. This exclusive seven-mile Black Point Trail tour is led by a certified eco-guide in a caravan, safari-style expedition on small 22-passenger deluxe mini coaches. Imagine a broad expanse of natural salt marsh with hammocks of palms and slash pines off in the distance. All around you, as far as your eyes can see are hundreds of thousands of birds, sometimes over 200 species. You'll make several lecture/photo stops along the trail. Then it's off to the manatee overlook area, the home of several pods of endangered manatees. From the seawall's edge, watch these gentle giants swim and play.
